I find that the *in forma pauperis* forms require amendments in an effort to improve clarity, create consistency among all courts, and comply with Rule 3(b), SCRCP. The following forms bearing a date of (6/2024) have been created or amended and are approved for use in circuit and family court effective June 28, 2024:

- SCCA 405.1 Order: *In Forma Pauperis*
- SCCA 405.2 *In Forma Pauperis* Procedure
